4. Documentation / Scrutineering

6. Entries

The entries open with the publication of these Supplementary Regulations and Early Bird Entries will be accepted up to 5pm Friday 4th May 2012. We have limited numbers for entries due to venue capacity. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry. Full entry fee must accompany your entry.

1. Entries will be accepted from multiple drivers (max 3) sharing the same car. It must be noted on each entry that the car is shared, and with which other driver(s).
2. Dual entries (two cars by one driver) will be accepted under the following conditions:
 1. The driver is to nominate his/her first choice of car for entry, the second car is not eligible for trophies, or club points.
3. Entries will be accepted to a maximum of 45 cars at this stage, this may change depending on venue, for more details please contact the Clerk of the Course.

7. Competitor Eligibility

- As this is a clubsport basic event, no membership or clubsport license is required. Civil License must be presented at Documentation.

8. Vehicle Eligibility

Vehicles must comply with Appendix 2, Schedule A, as per Motorsport New Zealand Manual 34

No competing vehicle may exceed the 95db noise level limit. The Clerk of the Course and/or his assistant will be the Judge(s) of Fact in this respect.

9. Start Order

All runs will be run in numerical order, any competitor unable to start in his/her correct order must notify and have permission from the Clerk of the Course in advance or forfeit that run.

The event will comprise of a practice run followed by timed runs.

11. Event Results

Run results will be available at the conclusion of each completed round. Time Keepers do not need to be distracted. Overall results will be posted at the conclusion of the event.

12. Damage to Property / Vehicle Recovery
